1. Out of District Attendance Agreements – West Valley students attending other districts
The agreements presented are for 1 student attending Helena Flats and 7 students attending in Kalispell Schools. Recommendation would be to acknowledge receipt of the Student Attendance Agreements.
2. Out of District Attendance Agreements – 4 Preschool students attending Special Needs PS
The tuition for these students is paid through permissive levy and will take place in the 19/20 school year.
3. Additional 6th grade Boys Basketball Coach: Teri Dierenfield
Due to 24 boys registered for 6th grade basketball as of October 17, Mr. Nickerson, AD, requested a second 6th grade boys basketball coach and is recommending Mrs. Dierenfield. Mrs. Dierenfield coached last year for us.
4. First Reading Policy Revision – 4330F
The district currently has policy 4330F and recommendation would be to add the Assumption of Risk paragraph to this form whereas an organization/individual requesting facility use will sign off agreeing to conditions.
